Alois HADAMCZIK

HEAD COACH

BORN: June 20, 1952 in Kravaře, Czechoslovakia

Alois Hadamczik, born 20th June 1952 in Kravaře, Czechoslovakia to a German-speaking family, had a first spell as head coach of Czech national team from 2006 to 2008. He has been promoted to this position once more in the summer of 2010, only a few weeks after Czech team won gold medals at IIHF World Championship in Germany.

Hadamczik started playing hockey quite late, on a midget level, and spent his active career mostly at regional clubs in Silesia. He started his coaching career at the age of 32 in Třinec, studying for a coaching degree at the Charles University in Prague at the same time.

In 1990 Hadamczik left for Germany and spent two years there. After his return he had short spells at Olomouc and Vítkovice, before returning to Třinec. During three years he achieved promotion twice, leading Třinec into the top division of Czech hockey in 1995. In the coming seasons, the team finished in a play-off position every season.

In 1998 Hadamczik left Třinec due to a troubled relation with the club's directors. However, he was back just one year later and steered the team to bronze medals. In the following season, Třinec was beaten in the quarterfinals and Hadamczik moved over to Vítkovice, a fierce regional rival. He finished third in his first season there and a runner-up one year later, losing only to Sparta Prague in the finals.

Sparta became Hadamczik's next career stop in 2002, but third place finish considered as disappointing hunted him again in both seasons in the Czech capital. In 2005 he was chosen as a successor to Vladimír Růžicka at the helm of Czech national team after a previous gold medal triumph at the World Championship in Austria. Hadamczik and his squad left for Riga one year later as underdogs, but still managed to grind out second place, shortly after capturing bronze at 2006 Olympics in Italy. However, the following two championships ended in quarterfinal disappointments and Hadamczik was replaced by Růžicka.

For 2008/09 season, he returned to Vítkovice and finished 8th in his first season. Just one year later, a revamped team went all the way to the Extraliga finals, losing to Pardubice in four straight games. The title once again eluded Hadamczik, but his work did not end unnoticed as he has begun his second spell as a head coach of Czech national team.



Josef PALEČEK

ASSISTANT COACH

BORN: May 5, 1949 in Starý Kolín, Czechoslovakia

Josef Paleček, born 5th May 1949, started ice hockey career at Kolín, but moved to Pardubice at the age of 18 and played 12 seasons for the local club, winning Czech title in 1973. During his military service, he was also playing for Dukla Jihlava, taking his league total to 451 games, scoring 171 goals.

His scoring skills did not go unnoticed and Paleček was present at three World Championships. In 1972 at Prague, he helped Czechoslovakia win gold medals alongside Ivan Hlinka, Jiří Holeček or Václav Nedomanský.

Paleček started coaching in the early 80's as a playing coach in Hradec Králové. After a short playing career in Austria and Germany, he switched to coaching on a full time basis. He moved up through the ranks of youth and junior teams to the helm of Pardubice senior squad, leading the team in three spells (1990-92, 1995-96 and 1999-02). In the process, he also became the club's sports director. Paleček's long career also features a short career in Denmark and a spell at Czech U19 national team.

In 2003/04 season, he was called up by struggling Liberec. It was too late to save a bad season in 2004, but the club flourished under Paleček's guidance in the following years, winning regular season of Czech Extraliga and bronze medals twice in three seasons. In 2007, Paleček decided to leave the club and became Alois Hadamczik's assistant coach at the helm of Czech national team.

However, just a few months later he returned to club coaching, accepting an offer from Karlovy Vary. In his very first season with the club, he helped to rewrite local hockey history, winning the Czech Extraliga title in 2009. He left the club in October of the same year, only to return in April 2010 for a short spell at the end of a season. In the summer, Paleček joined a new coaching staff of Czech national team.



Slavomír LENER GENERAL MANAGER



BORN: March 10, 1955 in Beroun, Czechoslovakia

Slavomir Lener, born 10th March 1955 in Beroun, Czechoslovakia, started playing hockey in Dobříš. Hockey was not his only interest, as he was into football and tennis, as well. After finishing high school, he moved to study for a coaching degree at Charles University in Prague under the guidance of the respected coach Vladimír Kostka.

During his military service in Jihlava, he helped with coaching of the local senior and junior teams. He had spells at Jihlava B (1980-81) and CLTK Praha (1981-86) before being employed by Czech Ice Hockey Association. He spent some time on an internship in China, but moved to Canada in 1990. Lener was working at Hockey Canada before joining NHL's Calgary Flames as an assistant coach. He spent seven years in the NHL, working for Flames (1992-95) and Florida Panthers (1998-02).

Lener became involved with Czech national teams, leading juniors to semifinals at 1996 World Junior Championship in Boston. In 1996, Lener together with Luděk Bukač guided Czech senior team to gold medals at World Championship in Austria, followed by two bronze medals in 1997 and 1998. He was an assistant coach of the famous team at 1998 Olympics in Nagano, Japan, leading Czech Republic to the arguably biggest victory of their hockey history. Lener later enjoyed some time as a head coach of the national team, working at 2003 and 2004 Championships in Helsinki and Prague, respectively.

In the meantime, his club career in Europe involved Sparta Prague (1996-98 and 2004-05), Düsseldorf in Germany (2007) and a couple of clubs in Sweden – Lulea (2005-07) and Linköping (2008-10).

In 2010, he became a Head of Coaching at Czech Ice Hockey Association.
